Varietal Composition	: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot.
Origin	: Central Valley.

Production	: 135.000 liters (15.000 C9L).



WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2014 blend is comprised of grapes from several vineyards in the Central Valley; there are grapes from Isla de Maipo and María Pinto in Maipo, vineyards from Santa Cruz in Colchagua, Molina, and finally Penciahue in the Maule Valley.

The grapes are harvested at night and then processed at the winery at first light, and fermentation begins relatively slowly in steel

tanks at a temperature range of 24°-28°C. Extraction is carried out through daily pumpovers that decrease in intensity as fermentation progresses. Once complete, some bases are aged in oak, whilst others remain as a fruit component in order to balance the final blend. Bottling of the wine began in November 2014.

Aging Potential: For its style and profile, it is best enjoyed within 2 years.

TASTING NOTES

Colour	: Ruby red.
Aroma	: Fresh and of great varietal character, with plenty of red fruit such as strawberry and cherry. Light vanilla hints are also present.
Flavour	: Medium structure, smooth tannins, very easy to drink.
