WINEMAKER NOTES

The Maule valley is the origin of 100% of the grapes, lending the Cabernet Sauvignon a fresh profile. The Syrah comes from Penciahue and is harvested early, giving for raspberry flavors and vivacity on the palate. The grapes are harvested at night to avoid oxidation and loss of aroma, then they are macerated for approximately 4 hours and pressed.

Once decanted, fermentation occurs in a reductive environment (without oxygen to avoid oxidation of aromas) at a low temperature for around 20 days. This year, we began bottling in July, giving for enhanced freshness and youth in the wine.

Aging potential: Recommended to drink within the year.
