## VARIETAL SYRAH 2015

Variety	: Syrah.
Varietal Composition	: 85% Syrah, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon.
Origin	: Central Valley.
Vintage	: 2015.
Yields	: 14-16 tons./hectare.
Harvest Date	: April-May 2015.
Production	: 108.000 liters (12.000 C9L).



### WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2015 blend is comprised of two vineyards: Maipo and Maule, with a little Syrah from the Leyda area. The grapes are harvested between April and May. They are processed at first light and fermentation begins in tanks for the extraction. Pumpovers occur daily, which decrease in intensity as fermentation progresses.

Once complete, some bases are aged in oak, whilst others are left as a fruit component that will be used to balance the final blend. Bottling of the wine began in November 2014.

Aging Potential: For its style and profile, the wine should be enjoyed within 2 to 3 years.

### TASTING NOTES

Colour	: Violet Red.
Aroma	: Fresh and with a fine varietal character. Notes of raspberry and cherry with hints of white pepper, herbs and smooth toasted notes.
Flavour	: Medium in structure, vibrant tannins.
